**Materials Description and Content:** *Spanish for Physical Therapists* (SPT) is published by Command Spanish®, Inc. and consists of a 35-page manual and accompanying audio files. In addition to a special section devoted to pronunciation, SPT contains the following work-specific language sections: Greetings and Goodbyes; Etiquette and Social Niceties; Introductions and Self-Identifications; Communication Strategies; Numbers; Diagnostic Questions; Patient Care Questions; Body Positioning Commands; Commands for Therapeutic Activities and Exercises; Motivating and Praising the Patient; Giving Directions for Standing Up, Sitting Down, Walking, and Stair Climbing; and Therapist Recommendations. The appendices include glossaries and diagrams for parts of the body, diseases, injuries, operations and procedures.

**Program Description:** This is a comprehensive Spanish language programs that provides immediate access to functional language skills for non-Spanish-speaking physical therapists who have a need to diagnose and treat Spanish-speaking patients in need of physical therapy. The language component utilizes phonetic encoding to address the most important commands, questions, and phrases pertinent to daily interactions in a physical therapy environment. **No prior knowledge of Spanish necessary.**

**Goal:** To provide non-Spanish-speaking physical therapists with specific Spanish language skills so that they will be better able to assist their Spanish-speaking patients.

**Objectives:** Upon completion, participants will be able to use Spanish to identify patients; introduce oneself; obtain diagnostic information; ask pertinent care questions; issue body positioning commands; issue commands for therapeutic exercises; motivate the patient; give directions for standing up, sitting down, walking, and stair climbing; and giving recommendations to patients.

**Intended Audience:** This is intended for non-Spanish-speaking physical therapists who may come into contact with Spanish-speaking patients.
